These two sisters (16 and 13) have been studying with Children's Future since February 2013. One day, they informed us that their parents had left indefinitely to find employment in Thailand.

Illegal migration is prominent in the area we operate in and puts young girls at especially high risk.

The girls were about to follow their parents with no idea of what would expect them across the border, when our Cambodian social workers were able to convince them to stay and continue their education instead. They lived in a hut with no walls and no door, so CFI built basic walls and a door that they can lock for their safety.

They attend school daily and are extremely committed students.
